

### Canvas padded bed head

**Purchase**

- Cheap artist canvases — we used 15 20cm square and 3 xx x xx for a single bed
- Polyester wadding
- Fabric — we used 1m but calculate based on size of canvas and width of fabric.
- Self covering button kit (optional) — we purchased a fantastic one from Daiso for \$2.80
- Embroidery thread (optional)

**Basic kit**

- Scissors
- Craft glue
- Cloth tape (optional)
- Large needle (optional)

### Coiled side table

**Purchase**

- Large heavy duty bucket
- Rope (we used fluoro rope)
- Tray (we used Ikea PS 2014 Tray)

**Recycled**

- Cardboard

**Basic kit**

- Craft glue
- Scissors

**Around the house**

- Soldering iron or gas lighter — to heat seal cut rope

### Glue resist cushions

**Purchase**

- Washable glue — we used Elmer's Washable, No Run School Glue which we bought at Officeworks
- Textile medium — we used Jo Sonja's Textile Medium from Spotlight
- Plain fabric — we used white polypop
- Cushion inserts

**Basic kit**

- Paint brush
- Acrylic paint
- Scissors
- Pins
- Tape measure
- Ruler or quilting square
- Frixion marker
- Thread to match your fabric

**Around the house**

- Ironing board and iron

**Extra kit**

- Sewing machine

### Paper cut lamp

**Recycled**

- Large plastic soft drink bottle with straight sides (we used a 2L Solo)

**Purchase**

- Paper punches

**Basic kit**

- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Glue stick
- A3 paper

### Pillow lounge

**Purchase/around the house**

- Doona cover — we used KRÅKRIS quilt cover from Ikea
- Cheap pillows (depends on size of doona but we used 5)

**Purchase**

- Roll of Ultrabond Heat N Bond
- Velcro (the length of your doona cover)

**Around the house**

- Iron and ironing board

- Craft glue
- Frixion marker

## Hot air balloons

### Purchase

- Fat quarters of fabric
- Paper lantern
- Disposable cup — a Styrofoam soup cup is perfect
- Mod Podge
- Noodle box

### Basic kit

- Scissors
- Paint brush
- Craft glue
- Scalpel
- Ruler
- A4 cardboard
- Straw paint
- Punch
- String

## Diy Light Box

### Purchase

- Shadow box frame (we used Ikea Ribba frame)
- Clear printable labels — they are very expensive from office supply stores but very cheap to purchase online at eBay etc.
- Battery operated LED fairy lights and batteries

### Basic kit

- Scissors
- Computer and printer
- Tape

## Mini robes

### Purchase

- Cheap flat pack book case (ours was \$12 from Big W)
- Curtain rail
- Spring loaded or tension curtain rail fitting (from curtain department at craft store)
- Kids size coat hangers
- Wooden legs (from hardware store)
- Wooden crate (optional)
- Wrapping paper for backing board

### Extra kit

- Drill
- Screw driver
- Hacksaw
- Little hammer

### Basic kit

- Scissors
- Glue stick

## Pennants

### Purchase

- A3 sheet of stiffened felt
- Fabric (fat quarter)
- Cord
- Ribbon and trims (optional)

### Purchase

- Foam board (also known as Foamcore)
- Chalkboard paint (you can buy small pots from craft stores)

- Pattern planner from our website

### Purchase

- Cheap shelving unit (ours was \$12 from Bunnings)
- Fabric (we used Polyprop) — amounts are indicated on pattern planner
- Ultrabond Heat N Bond
- Velcro dots (optional to keep flap closed)

### Around the house

- Iron and ironing board

### Basic kit

- Craft glue
- Tape measure
- Pins
- Frixion marker
- Large ruler
- Scissors
- Paint, brush, sponge (optional)

## Triangle clocks

### Purchase

- Large size origami paper
- Clock hands and movement (from craft store)
- A4 sheet of foam core

### Purchase

- 12 C6 envelopes
- Clock hands and movement
- A4 sheet of foam core
